As directed by <u>SDCL 13-10-12</u> and organizational policy, Northeast Educational Services Cooperative (NESC) conducts criminal background checks for prospective employees, contracted service providers, and field experience applicants who will have contact with children. However, you must let us know of your intent to appeal within 5 days of the date you were informed of that disqualification.
