# PRIM-3 Behavior Checklist<sup>i</sup>

### **Academic Performance**

- is reluctant to learn or attempt new tasks
- does not remain on-task for the required length of time
- does not read or follow written directions
- does not start assignments independently
- rushes through activities or assignments with little or no regard to accuracy, quality, or neatness
- does not complete assignments independently
- fails to complete homework assignments and return them to school

# **Interpersonal Relationships**

- makes unnecessary noises in the classroom
- makes unnecessary physical contact with others
- has little or no interaction with peers
- has little or no interaction with teachers
- makes inappropriate comments to other students
- makes inappropriate comments to teachers
- is not accepted by other students
- refuses to share possessions or materials
- bothers others who are trying to work

### **Depression / Motivation**

- has unexcused tardiness
- has unexcused absences
- blames other people or materials to avoid taking responsibility for mistakes or failures
- blames self for situations beyond his / her own control
- is not motivated by rewards
- responds inappropriately to constructive criticism or comments from others
- tries to avoid situations, assignments, or responsibilities
- threatens to hurt self or commit suicide
- does not smile, laugh, or demonstrate happiness
- cheats
- does not care about performance, grades, report cards, graduating, consequences of behavior, etc.
- does not care for personal appearance
- is overly pessimistic

### **Inappropriate Behavior Under Normal Circumstances**

- behaves inappropriately when others do well or receive praise or attention
- acts impulsively without apparent self-control
- exhibits sudden or extreme mood changes
- moves about unnecessarily
- becomes overexcited
- lies, denies, exaggerates, distorts the truth
- speaks in an unnatural voice
- engages in nervous habits
- does not accept changes in an established routine
- does not transition from one activity to another without difficulty
- does not demonstrate appropriate mealtime behavior

#### **Rules and Expectations**

- uses obscene or profane language
- does not demonstrate the ability to follow a routine
- does not take appropriate care of personal property
- does not follow directives from teachers or other school personnel
- brings inappropriate or illegal materials to school
- responds inappropriately to redirection
- does not raise hand when appropriate
- does not take notes in class when necessary
- talks to others during quiet activity periods
- leaves seat or assigned area without permission

## **Group Behavior**

- demonstrates inappropriate behavior when moving with a group	
- behaves more appropriately alone or in small groups than in large group activities	
- does not demonstrate appropriate behavior in the presence of a substitute	
- does not demonstrate appropriate behavior in group activities (e.g. taking turns or sharing)
