

Validating IEPs Without Transition

Introduction

Sometimes, when trying to validate a student's IEP, transition errors may appear even though a student's age does not yet require transition material. These particular errors can be ignored and overridden.

Procedure

1. Click any of the blue links in the validation errors to move forward to the transition section of the validation report.
